At that time, regulations and business pertaining to the operation of the Game and Fish Commission and other fiscal and administrative matters will be considered and acted upon, and all interested persons are invited to attend. Items on the agenda for the May 19, 2011, 10:00 a.m. meeting will include adoption of proposed regulations previously considered at the April 21, 2011, Commission Meeting, plus various Hunting and Fishing Regulations and regulations pertaining to the Enforcement Division of the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission, including, but not limited to:

- 1. **License & Permit Requirements** Amend existing regulations to provide for issuance of lifetime hunting and fishing licenses (with optional lifetime trout stamp and lifetime state duck stamp) to resident military retirees who are sixty (60) years of age or older and disabled military veterans.
- 2. **Commission Committee Procedures** -- Amend existing agency procedures for conduct of Commission business through the use of committees (redesignate standing committees, etc.).
- 3. Oil and Gas Activities (If not already approved at April 21, 2011 Commission Meeting) Adopt proposed Oil and Gas Lease Agreements (non-drilling / non-surface disturbance) affecting (a) Cow Shoals Access / Little Red River, Cleburne County; (b) Greers Ferry Nursery Pond, Cleburne County; and (c) Lake Barnett, White County. Also, adopt amendment to existing Oil and Gas Lease Agreement and adopt proposed Pipeline Right of Way Agreement affecting Scott Henderson Gulf Mountain Wildlife Management Area, Van Buren County.
