01.00-J POINT SYSTEM FOR HUNTING AND/OR FISHING VIOLATIONS

6-11

Upon the accumulation of 12 points for hunting and/or fishing violations within a three-year period, the individual will be ineligible to apply for any Commission deer, turkey and elk permit hunts for the following three years. The accumulation of 18 points for hunting and/or fishing violations within a three-year period may result in the revocation of all hunting and/or fishing licenses and the rights attached thereto for one year, and the accumulation of 30 points within a five-year period may result in the loss of all licenses and rights for three years. A revocation of hunting and/or fishing licenses and rights occurring for a third time during an individual's lifetime may result in the lifetime revocation of all hunting and/or fishing licenses and rights. Any person who forfeits bond, pleads guilty or nolo contendere, or is found guilty of violating any hunting or fishing regulation shall be assigned points as follows:

The following violations shall result in a double assessment of the respective point value for the violation committed upon final court disposition:

- 1) Any violation of harvest regulations committed by a Guide License holder.
- 2) Any violation of trout harvest regulations in a trout catch and release area.
- 3) Any violation of bass harvest regulations on lakes designated as Trophy Bass Management Areas (Lakes Monticello, Lower White Oak, Columbia, SWEPCO, Pickthorne and Austelle).
- 4) Adults 21 years or older when accompanying youth under 16.

01.00-K SUSPENSION, REVOCATION OR DENIAL OF LICENSES, PERMITS,

TAGS AND STAMPS. The Director of the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission, or his designated representative, is authorized to deny, suspend or revoke the license, permit, tag or stamp of any holder, and to deny the application of any applicant, upon proper notice and hearing in accordance with due process, upon reasonable cause or a showing through the Commission's records or other sufficient evidence that the holder or applicant has met one or more of the following criteria:

- (1) accumulated points for hunting and/or fishing violations in excess of the amounts set forth in Commission Code 01:00-J;
- (2) made a material misrepresentation or practiced fraud or deceit in an attempt to obtain or use a license, permit, tag or stamp;
- (3) permitted a fraudulent or unlawful use of his license, permit, tag or stamp;
- (4) under either federal law or another state's law, has received a lifetime revocation of his or her hunting and/or fishing licenses, or been convicted within the past three years of a hunting and/or fishing violation, which, if the conviction had been pursuant to Arkansas law, would have been grounds for suspension or revocation; or
- (5) Failed to comply with any term of a license, permit, tag or stamp.

Upon suspension or revocation of any license, permit, tag or stamp, or denial of any application, the Director, or his designated representative, shall notify the holder or applicant in writing. Any holder or applicant desiring a hearing shall notify the Commission in writing within twenty (20) days after receipt of the suspension, revocation or denial notice. Upon receipt of the hearing request, the Commission shall appoint a hearing officer and notify the holder or applicant of the date, time and location of the hearing. The Commission shall cause an official record to be made of the proceedings. Hearings shall be conducted in an informal manner and without necessity of adherence to the rules of evidence required in judicial proceedings. Parties shall have the right to be represented by counsel, to submit evidence in open hearing, compel the attendance of witnesses and to cross-examine any witness at the hearing. Irrelevant, immaterial or unduly repetitious evidence shall be excluded by the hearing officer. Notice may be taken of generally recognized technical or scientific facts within the Commission's specialized knowledge, and the Commission's experience, technical competence and specialized knowledge may be utilized in the evaluation of the evidence. Based upon the evidence in the record of the proceedings, the hearing officer shall affirm. rescind, or modify the suspension or revocation of the license, permit, tag or stamp, or the denial of the application. Decisions of the hearing officer shall be final and shall include findings of fact, conclusions of law and the final order. The parties shall be served either personally or by mail with a copy of the final decision. Any aggrieved party may, within thirty days after service of the decision, file a petition for review in the circuit court of Pulaski County or the county in which they reside.

HUNTING OR FISHING AFTER REVOCATION OF LICENSE 11.04

05-05/6-11 **PROHIBITED.** It shall be unlawful for any person to take or attempt to take any wildlife, including fish, by any means after suspension of the person's hunting and/or fishing license by any court or the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission or its authorized representative for the period of such suspension.

PENALTY: \$500.00 to \$2,000.00.

and in addition a jail sentence not to exceed 10 days may be imposed. Equipment used in such violations (including but not limited to killing devices and lights) may be confiscated by the court, forfeited to the State. and disposed of according to law.

REVOCATION OF LICENSES. Courts of competent jurisdiction 11.05

or the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission by its authorized representatives may 10-98/6-11 suspend, revoke or deny a permit, license, tag or stamp for reasonable cause. Any suspension, revocation or denial of permits, licenses, tags, stamps or rights attached thereto by the Commission or its authorized representative shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions in Code Regulation 01.00-K.

REVOCATION OF COMMERCIAL WILDLIFE PERMITS. It 11.05-A

shall be unlawful for any person to take, attempt to take, possess, buy, sell, acquire or 04-05/6/11 dispose, in any manner, wildlife for commercial purposes after the person's commercial wildlife permit has been suspended by any court, the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission, or its authorized representative.

1st Offense - \$1,000.00 - \$5,000.00. In addition, a jail sentence not to PENALTY: exceed ten (10) days may be imposed. Subsequent Offenses - \$5,000.00 - \$10.000.00. In addition, a jail sentence not to exceed one (1) year may be imposed.

ACCESS ON COMMISSION-OWNED WMAs AND WDAs PROHIBITED 11.06

AFTER REVOCATION OF HUNTING LICENSE. It shall be unlawful for any person to access or go upon any Commission-owned WMA or WDA after revocation of the person's hunting license by a court of competent jurisdiction or the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission or its authorized representative for the period of such revocation.

PENALTY: \$500.00 to \$2,000.00.

ACCESS ON COMMISSION-OWNED LAKES PROHIBITED AFTER 11.07

> **REVOCATION OF FISHING LICENSE.** It shall be unlawful for any person to access or go upon any Commission-owned lake after revocation of the person's fishing license by a court of competent jurisdiction or the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission or its authorized representative for the period of such revocation.

PENALTY: \$500.00 to \$2,000.00.
