

## LEGAL NOTICE

The regular monthly meeting of the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission will be held beginning at 10:00 a.m. Thursday, May 15, 2014, at the Little Rock Office Complex, 2 Natural Resources Drive, Little Rock, AR 72205. At that time, regulations and business pertaining to the operation of the Game and Fish Commission and other fiscal and administrative matters will be considered and acted upon, and all interested persons are invited to attend. Additionally, Committee meetings attended by Commissioners and agency staff members will be held throughout the day on Wednesday, May 14, 2014, beginning at 10:00 a.m. at the same location, and all interested persons are invited to attend.

Items on the agenda for the May 15, 2014, 10:00 a.m. meeting will include adoption of proposed regulations previously considered at the April 17, 2014, Commission Meeting, plus various Hunting and Fishing Regulations and regulations pertaining to the Enforcement Division of the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission, including, but not limited to:

1. **Fishing Regulations - Lake Chicot and Cane Creek Lake Drawdown Daily Creel Limit Changes** – Adoption of general fishing regulation changes including, but not limited to:
  - Amend daily limit for all sportfish on Lake Chicot to one-half of the existing Lake Chicot daily limit (no limit for catfish) during the lake drawdown (planned for July 7- December 31, 2014).
  - Amend daily limit for all sportfish on Cane Creek Lake to one-half of the existing Cane Creek Lake daily limit (crappie daily limit 7) during the lake drawdown (planned for July 7 – December 31, 2014).
2. **U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Transfer of St. Francis Basin Mitigation Lands in Clay, Craighead, Greene, and Poinsett Counties, AR** – Approval of the conveyance of real property (44 tracts, approx. 12,648 acres) in Clay, Craighead, Greene, and Poinsett Counties by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to the State of Arkansas through the Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission for operating, maintaining and managing the property for fish and wildlife, recreation, and environmental purposes.
