Canada Goose Statewide Season:

- o 1st segment: Sept. 1-30 annually
- o 2nd segment: the last Saturday in October for 4 consecutive days
- o 3rd segment: the Saturday before Thanksgiving through the first Friday of December
- 4th segment: the first Sunday in December through January 31

Shooting hours are from 1/2 hour before sunrise to sunset statewide.

EXCEPTION:Holla Bend NWR is closed.

LIMIT: Daily limit 2, possession limit 6.

EXCEPTION: The daily limit is 5 Canada geese from September 1 - 30 annually, possession limit 15.
