The regulations in this Code Book are hereby adopted by the Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission under authority of Amendment 35 to the Constitution of the State of Arkansas. All laws, rules, regulations, or orders in conflict with the regulations in this Code Book are hereby repealed by the Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission.

26.15 Taking Suckers Restricted

It is unlawful to take more than 20 suckers daily or to possess more than two daily limits taken by gigging, hogging or snagging. Legal methods for taking suckers are as follows:

- A. Gigging
- B. Hogging/Noodling in compliance with Code 26.05
- C. Snagging fromsunrise-sunset, April 1-February15 statewide, in compliance with Code 26.17
- D. Sport fishing tacklein compliance with Chapter 26.00
- E. Commercial tackle in compliance with Chapter 30.00
