Regulation Correction and Clarification Proposals

Proposal: Modify Code 03.04 (Nonresident Hunting License Requirements) and Addendum D1.01 (Licenses, Permits, Stamps, Tags, Costs and Expiration Dates) to add the Nonresident Turkey Tag back to the code. This change allows persons with a Nonresident Annual Hunting License to purchase one turkey tag.

Codes affected: 03.04, D1.01

Proposal: Modify Code 06.02 (Certain Firearms and Ammunition Prohibited During Modern Gun Deer Seasons) to clarify and correct the following:

- prohibited alternative firearms that are unlawful for use during the modern gun season;
- non-semi automatic straight-walled rifles may not be used during the modern gun season in zones 4 and 5;
- handgun caliber that can be used during the statewide modern gun season must be .30 or larger which is consistent with the code requirement in zones 4 and 5 and alternative firearms season;
- that hunting with only lead and lead alloy, soft-nose and/or hollow point bullets is not required in zones 4 and 5 Allow the use of rifles which fire straight-walled cartridges .30 caliber and larger in Deer Zones 4 and 5 for modern gun deer season; and,
- that there are no longer killing device requirements for the private land antlerless modern gun deer hunt that was removed from the code in the regulation proposal adopted in May 2024.

Proposal: Modify Code 06.03 (Certain Firearms Prohibited During Alternative Firearms Season) to clarify and correct the following:

- prohibited killing devices, including shotguns, that are unlawful during the alternative firearms season;
- lawful straight-walled cartridges must be metallic; and,
- handguns having barrels no less than 4 inches in length and chambered specifically for straight-walled centerfire cartridges cases .30 caliber or larger may be used during the alternative firearms season.

Proposal: Modify Code 08.02 (Dogs Chasing Wildlife For Training) to remove the word "training" from this code to remove potential conflict with Code 08.03 (Deer Dog Training Restrictions).

Codes affected: 08.02

Proposal: Modify Code 08.03 (Deer Dog Training Restrictions) to clarify that nonresidents may not use dogs to chase deer except during the last nine days of the regular modern gun season in accordance with Code 08.04 (Hunting Deer with Dogs Prohibited).

Codes affected: 08.03

Proposal: Modify Code 08.04 (Hunting Deer with Dogs) to clarify and correct the following:

- nonresidents may use dogs for deer hunting on private and public land only during the last nine days of the regular modern gun deer season in Deer Zones 6, 7, 8, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16A and 17 and on WMAs open to hunting deer;
- private land anterless hunt was removed from the code; and,
- code references to deer season and limit restrictions on WMAs.

Codes affected: 08.04

Proposal: Modify Code 20.17 (Seasons Restrictions During Permit Hunts on WMAs) to clarify that deer may be hunted on WMAs with dove permit hunts during the buck-only archery hunt. Currently, those WMAs with dove permit hunts would be closed to the buck-only archery hunt.

Codes affected: 20.17

Proposal: Modify Code 22.01 (Dog Restrictions on WMAs) to simplify the code regulating the WMAs where dogs may be used during modern gun season. Currently, the WMAs are listed in two parts of this code.

Codes affected: 22.01

Proposal: Modify Addendum A1.01 (Deer Season and Limits) to clarify the early season archery hunt (i.e., velvet hunt) is restricted to bucks only and no more than one deer may be harvested and add a code reference to Addendum C1.01.

Codes affected: A1.01

Proposal: Modify Addendum C1.01 (Deer Season and Limit Restrictions on WMAs) to clarify deer season limit restrictions on WMAs, including the use of dogs by nonresidents during the last nine days of the modern gun season, removal of Ozark National Forest WMA from the code and adjusting bag limits on Pond Creek NWR requested by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service.

Codes affected: C1.01

Proposal: Modify Addendum C1.02 (Bear Season and Limit Restrictions on WMAs) to adjust the alternative firearms bear season dates to the third Saturday in October for 5 days on Harold E. Alexander WMA to coincide with the deer permit hunt as permit holders may only hunt bears during this time.

A1.01 Deer Season And Limits

ARCHERY AND CROSSBOW

All private land deer zones and AGFC-owned or leased WMAs **buck-only archery hunt**: first Saturday in September for three days (Codes 06.04 – 06.05). **No more than one legal buck may be harvested.**

All deer zones: Fourth Saturday in September through the last day in February (Codes <u>06.04</u> – <u>06.05</u>). **EXCEPTIONS**:

- A. In compliance with WMA regulations (Addendum C1.01).
- B. Urban Deer Permits (Code 15.05).

MODERN GUN

Zones 1, 2, 3, 6, 7, 8, 10 and 11: Second Saturday in November for 23 days.

Zones 4A, 5A, 14 and 15: Second Saturday in November for 30 days.

Zones 4 and 5: Second Saturday in November for 9 days.

Zones 9, 12 and 13: Second Saturday in November for 37 days.

Zones 16, 16A and 17: Second Saturday in November through Christmas Day.

EXCEPTIONS:

- A. In compliance with WMA regulations (Addendum <u>C1.01</u>).
- B. Deer Management Assistance Program (DMAP) Deer Management Tags.
- C. Private Land CWD Management Tags.

CHRISTMAS HOLIDAY MODERN GUN DEER HUNT

All deer zones: December 26-28, Annually. **EXCEPTIONS**:

- A. WMAs closed during modern gun deer season are excluded from the Christmas Holiday Deer Hunt (Addendum C1.01).
- B. WMAs requiring a permit for the modern gun or alternative firearms deer season are excluded from the Christmas Holiday Deer Hunt (Addendum <u>C1.01</u>).
- C. In compliance with applicable WMA regulations (Addendum <u>C1.01</u>).
- D. Deer Management Assistance Program (DMAP) Deer Management Tags.
- E. Private Land CWD Management Tags.

SPECIAL YOUTH MODERN GUN DEER HUNT

All deer zones: First Saturday in November for 2 days and the first Saturday in January for 2 days.

EXCEPTIONS:

- A. In compliance with WMA regulations (Addendum C1.01).
- B. WMAs requiring a WMA deer permit are closed to the Special Modern Gun Deer Youth Hunt (Addendum <u>C1.01</u>).

- C. Deer Management Assistance Program (DMAP) Deer Management Tags.
- D. Private Land CWD Management Tags.

ALTERNATIVE FIREARMS

Zones 1, 2, 3, 6, 7, 8, 10 and 11: Third Saturday in October for 9 days and second Saturday in December for 3 days.

Zones 4A, 5A, 14 and 15: Third Saturday in October for 9 days and third Saturday in December for 3 days.

Zones 9, 12, 13, 16, 16A and 17: Third Saturday in October for 9 days.

EXCEPTIONS:

- A. In areas open during regular gun deer seasons.
- B. In compliance with WMA regulations (Addendum C1.01).
- C. Deer Management Assistance Program (DMAP) Deer Management Tags.
- D. Private Land CWD Management Tags.

LIMIT

Statewide seasonal limit of 6 deer, no more than 2 legal bucks using any legal method.

Zones 1, 2, 3, 6, 7, 8, 10, 11, and 13: Seasonal bag limit of 5 deer, no more than 2 antlered bucks. No more than 2 antlered bucks or up to 5 antlerless may be taken with archery tackle. No more than 2 antlered bucks and 3 antlerless deer may be taken with firearms. Zones 8 and 9 in Jackson and Independence County: Seasonal bag limit of 5 deer, no more than 2 antlered bucks or up to 5 antlerless deer may be taken with archery tackle. No more than 2 antlered bucks or up to 5 antlerless deer may be taken with firearms.

Zones 9, 14, 15, 16, and 16A: Seasonal bag limit of 4 deer, no more than 2 legal bucks. No more than 2 legal bucks or up to 4 does may be taken with archery tackle. No more than 2 legal bucks and 2 does may be taken with firearms. Zones 16A in Ashley County: Seasonal bag limit of 4 deer, no more than 2 antlered bucks or up to 4 antlerless deer may be taken with archery tackle. No more than 2 antlered bucks or up to 2 antlerless deer may be taken with firearms.

Zones 4 and 5: Seasonal bag limit of 3 deer, no more than 2 legal bucks. No more than 2 legal bucks or up to 3 does may be taken with archery tackle. No more than 2 legal bucks

and 1 doe may be taken with firearms. Zones 4 and 5 in Craighead, Jackson, Mississippi, and Randolph Counties: Seasonal bag limit of 3 deer, no more than 2 antlered bucks or up to 3 antlerless deer may be taken with archery tackle. No more than 2 antlered bucks or up to 1 antlerless deer may be taken with firearms.

Zones 4A and 5A: Seasonal bag limit of 3 deer, no more than 2 legal bucks. No more than 2 legal bucks or up to 3 does may be taken with archery tackle. No more than 2 legal bucks or up to 2 does may be taken with firearms.

Zones 12 and 17: Seasonal bag limit of 5 deer, no more than 2 legal bucks. No more than 2

legal bucks or up to 5 does may be taken with archery tackle. No more than 2 legal bucks or up to 5 does may be taken with firearms. Zone 12 in Ashley, Bradley and Union Counties and Zone 17 in Mississippi County: Seasonal bag limit of 5 deer, no more than 2 antlered bucks. No more than 2 antlered bucks or up to 5 antlerless deer may be taken with archery tackle. No more than 2 antlered bucks or up to 5 antlerless deer may be taken with firearms.

Nonresidents may use dogs for deer hunting only during the last nine days of the regular modern gun deer season in Deer Zones 6, 7, 8, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16A and 17 and WMAs open to hunting deer with dogs (Code 22.01 and Addendum C1.01). Limit one deer of either sex during the nine day period.

Youths 6 to 15 years of age hunting during the Special Youth Modern Gun Deer Hunt may harvest bucks or does during the first full weekend Saturday/Sunday in November for 2 days and the first Saturday in January for 2 days in accordance with the zone firearm bag limits.

EXCEPTIONS:

- A. Commission-registered deer camps that participate in the Deer Management Assistance Program (DMAP) receiving deer management tags and bonus deer on certain WMAs (Addendum <u>C1.01</u>) do not apply toward an individual seasonal limit.
- B. Subject to applicable limit restrictions on WMAs (Addendum <u>C1.01</u>).
- C. Private Land CWD Management Tags.

LEGAL NOTICE

The regular monthly meeting of the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission will be held beginning at 9:00 a.m. Thursday, July 18, 2024, at the Arkansas Game & Fish Headquarters located at 2 Natural Resources Drive, Little Rock, AR 72205. At that time, regulations and business pertaining to the operation of the Game and Fish Commission and other fiscal and administrative matters will be considered and acted upon. Additionally, Committee meetings attended by Commissioners and agency staff members will be held throughout the day on Wednesday, July 17, 2024, beginning at 8:00 a.m. at the Arkansas Game & Fish Headquarters located at 2 Natural Resources Drive, Little Rock, AR 72205. All interested persons are invited to attend these meetings.

The Commission meeting on July 18th will be live-streamed and a link for easy viewing access will be available on the agency website. Please visit the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission website at https://www.agfc.com for additional up-to-date details as the meeting dates draw closer.

Items on the agenda for the July 18, 2024 meeting will include discussion and/or adoption of proposed regulations that previously were considered at the May 15-16 and June 19-20, 2024 Commission Meetings, plus consideration of various Hunting and Fishing Regulations and regulations pertaining to the Enforcement Division of the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission, including but not limited to:

- 1. **General Hunting Regulations** Adopt general hunting regulations for 2024-2025 and 2025-2026. Changes to regulations include, but are not limited to:
- Modify the existing code that prohibits possession of a firearm while archery or crossbow hunting bear, deer, or turkey, to allow person tracking wounded big game to possess a firearm legal for the hunting season;
- Add back the Nonresident Turkey Tag (NRT) to allow Nonresident Annual Hunting License (NBG) holders to add one turkey tag at a discounted price over the standalone Non-Resident Annual Turkey Hunting License (NRTT);
- Clarify firearms and ammunition that are unlawful for use during the modern gun season;
- Prohibit non-semiautomatic straight-walled rifles during the modern gun season in Zones 4 and 5;
- Clarify that the handgun caliber that can be used during the statewide modern gun season must be .30 or larger consistent with the code requirement in Zones 4 and 5 and alternative firearms season:
- Clarify that hunting with only lead and lead alloy, soft-nose, and/or hollow point bullets is not required in Zones 4 and 5;
- Allow the use of rifles firing straight-walled cartridges .30 caliber or larger in Deer Zones 4 and 5 for modern gun deer season;
- Remove certain killing device requirements for the private land antlerless modern gun deer hunt:
- Prohibit arrows propelled by the action of an explosive or combustible propellant and shotguns during alternative firearms season;
- Modify exception to allow non-semiautomatic centerfire firearms firing straight-walled metallic cartridges .30 caliber or larger during alternative firearms season;

- Modify exception to allow use of handguns having barrels no less than 4 inches in length and chambered specifically for straight-walled centerfire cartridges cases .30 caliber or larger during the alternative firearms season;
- Clarify that it is unlawful to use a dog to chase any wildlife during the day from April 1-May 15 or in any open spring turkey season, alternative firearms deer season, or modern gun deer season, in a zone where hunting with dogs is prohibited or to possess a killing device while using a dog to chase wildlife, with the exception that dogs may be used to chase fox or coyote within fox or coyote enclosures day or night all year;
- Clarify that Nonresidents may not use dogs to chase deer except during the last nine days of the regular modern gun season;
- Clarify that Nonresidents may use dogs for deer hunting on private and public land only during the last nine days of the regular modern gun deer season in Deer Zones 6, 7, 8, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16A, and 17 and on WMAs open to hunting deer;
- Remove restriction to allow the use of dogs for hunting deer during private land antlerless only modern gun deer season;
- Include exception to season restrictions during permit hunts on WMAs to allow deer to be hunted during the buck-only archery hunt;
- Allow hunting deer with dogs during modern gun deer season during specific dates on Blue Mountain, Dardanelle, DeGray Lake, Gum Flats, Lake Greeson, Provo, Mount Magazine, Nimrod Lloyd Millwood, and Ozark Lake WMAs;
- Restrict dogs from islands within Blue Mountain, Dardanelle, DeGray Lake, Nimrod Lloyd Millwood, and Ozark Lake WMAs, except for hunting furbearers at night and waterfowl;
- Modify archery and crossbow deer seasons and limits to clarify the early season archery hunt (i.e., velvet hunt) is restricted to bucks only and no more than one deer may be harvested;
- Clarify that alternative firearms season opens in accordance with season dates and weapon restrictions set by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service on Bald Knob, Cache River, Overflow, and Pond Creek NWRs;
- Clarify that alternative firearms season and alternative firearms permit hunt opens in accordance with season dates and weapon restrictions set by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service on Dale Bumpers White River NWR;
- Clarify that the alternative firearms permit hunt opens in accordance with season dates and weapon restrictions set by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service on Felsenthal NWR;
- Modify the limit during the alternative firearms permit hunt on Bell Slough WMA to 2 deer, consisting of 1 buck and 1 doe;
- Clarify that the limit during the modern gun special youth permit hunt and modern gun youth hunt on Bell Slough WMA is 4 deer, consisting of 2 bucks (no antler restrictions) and 2 does;
- Allow Nonresidents to take 1 deer during the last nine days of the modern gun season on Blue Mountain, Dardanelle, DeGray Lake, Gum Flats, Lake Greeson, Mount Magazine WMA, Nimrod Lloyd Millwood, Ozark Lake, and Provo WMAs;
- Modify modern gun season dates on Brushy Creek WMA to the second Saturday in November for 9 days and December 26-28 annually;
- Add an alternative firearms permit hunt on Camp Robinson SUA to be held the third Saturday in October for 3 days;

- Allow the taking of 1 buck and 1 doe with alternative firearm and modern gun permit on Camp Robinson SUA;
- Allow the taking of 1 antlered buck or antlerless with alternative firearms permit on Fort Chaffee WMA;
- Clarify the seasonal limit on Hobbs State Park-Conservation Area to include 4 deer, with no more than 1 antlered buck (no antler restrictions);
- Remove erroneous, outdated references to Ozark National Forest WMA;
- No longer require that a doe be harvested and checked at the refuge check station before a second buck may be harvested with any weapon on Pond Creek NWR;
- Modify season limits on Pond Creek NWR to include 1 buck with archery, 3 does with archery, 1 buck or up to 2 does with alternative firearms, 1 buck and 1 doe with modern gun permit, limit during the mobility-impaired permit hunt is 3 deer with no more than 1 buck or up to 3 does;
- Clarify limits on Stone Prairie WMA during alternative firearms permit hunt, modern gun special youth hunt, and modern gun youth hunt to include 2 deer, consisting of 1 buck (no antler restrictions) and 1 doe;
- Modify bear season dates on Harold E. Alexander Spring River WMA during alternative firearms season to the third Saturday in October for 5 days (deer permit holders only, zone quota does not apply), statewide limit applies.
