State Plant Board Quarterly Meeting and Public Hearings

The Arkansas State Plant Board will meet at 10:00 a.m., Wednesday, December 20, 2006 at the State Plant Board offices, #1 Natural Resources, Drive, Little Rock, AR.

1. **Public Hearings**:

A) <u>Public Hearing</u> to consider the following changes in the seed regulations:

The Plant Board recently directed the Seed Division to formulate a proposed regulation to amend the regulations in Circular 15: Official Standards for Seed Certification in Arkansas (Under Act 73, A. C. A. 1987, Sections 2-18-101 - 2-18-108). The vegetatively propagated turfgrass standards in these regulations require isolation distances, land requirements and three inspections during the growing season to determine varietal purity of turfgrass sod. The proposed changes are to make the fees more equitable for small and large acreage turfgrass companies, and still cover the expenses of providing the turfgrass certification program. Currently the acreage fees are \$30 / acre and cover three required inspections and labels (certificates). The proposed fees of \$500 for the first 10 acres and \$12 / acre for each additional acre are being put forward as a more equitable fee structure for companies that participate in the certified turfgrass program.

B) Public Hearing to consider changes to the Regulations on Plant Diseases and Pests:

The hearing will be to address the inclusion of language in the rule that will allow Arkansas forest tree nurseries to utilize inputs, methyl bromide, in the production of seedlings for sale intra-state. Current federal regulations allow for this usage in interstate commerce. With there not being a suitable replacement for this chemical, nurseries from outside Arkansas are able to produce and sell seedlings inside the state at a lower price than the Arkansas nurseries.

C) <u>Public Hearing</u> to consider changes to the Regulations on Plant Diseases and Pests:

The hearing will be to establish regulations for the purpose of reviewing information on and rejecting or allowing production of rice having characteristics of economic impact in Arkansas. This is to comply with Act 1238 as passed by the Arkansas legislature in 2005.
