**SUBJECT: Pre-Release Program** 

# I. <u>AUTHORITY</u>:

The authority of the Board of Correction to promulgate this administrative regulation is vested in Act 50 of 1968, First Extraordinary Session.

# II. <u>PURPOSE</u>:

The purpose of this administrative regulation is to make available to inmates information and assistance in release planning; to provide each inmate the opportunity to discuss anxieties and solve problems relating to his or her release and future adjustment; and to describe the pre-release programming available.

# III. <u>APPLICABILITY</u>:

<u>This administrative regulation applies</u> to all staff and especially those involved in the pre-release selection and/or program; and inmates <u>eligible for release</u>.

## <u>IV.</u> <u>DEFINITIONS</u>:

Pre-Release Program: This shall be defined as a program within the Department of Correction designed to give information to inmates to help them make a successful transition from the Department back to the community.

## **IVV. POLICY**:

It shall be the policy of the Department of Correction to provide inmates the opportunity to participate in a program designed specifically to prepare the inmate for release from the Department.

## **YVI. PROCEDURE**:

Programs to prepare inmates for release may include, but will not be limited to, the following: lectures and discussions that address the concerns of soon-to-be released inmates; <u>and</u>, individual counseling that focuses on each inmate's particular needs; <u>and short furloughs for completing a release plan</u>.

# A. Eligibility Criteria for Benton Pre-Release Coordinator

A Pre-Release Coordinator shall be designated and shall be responsible for maintaining and monitoring a current list of inmates who are eligible for the pre-release program. The transfer of inmates to a designated pre-release program shall be coordinated through the Pre-Release Coordinator.

## B. <u>Eligibility Criteria for Pre-Release</u>

1. All inmates selected to participate in the program shall should not be more than the maximum number of days as established by the appropriate administrative directive from their parole/transfer eligibility or release discharge date.

- 2. Inmate convicted of certain crimes or serving specific sentences shall not be eligible to participate in the program. Additional specific eligibility criteria shall be identified in the appropriate administrative directive.
- 3. Additional specific eligibility criteria to include but not be limited to security risk, medical status, and disciplinary status shall be identified in the appropriate administrative directive. The transfer of the inmate to a pre-release program must be approved by the appropriate staff at the receiving—unit Classification Committee.

## B. Selection Process and Transfer to the Benton Unit Pre-Release Center

- 1. A screening committee shall review the institutional file of the inmates

  determined to be eligible for transfer to the program.
- 2. The transfer of the inmate to the pre-release program must be approved by appropriate staff.
- 3. All records of each inmate and a supply of prescribed medication(s) shall be forwarded to the Benton Unit at the time of transfer.

#### C. Pre-Release Programs Other Than Benton Unit

1. Pre-Release programs may be conducted at other units/centers for those inmates ineligible for transfer to the Benton Unit.

#### DC. Release Procedures

1. The parole officer assigned to the <u>designated</u> Pre-Release <u>Program staff</u> will coordinate with institutional parole officers and <u>institutional release officers and</u>

field officers to assure a continuity of parole services for each inmate scheduled to be released from the program on parole.

2. The Supervisor of the Pre-Release Program staff will be responsible to the warden/center supervisor of the pre-release unit/center for administering and coordinating proper procedures for release assisting as necessary in the release of inmates assigned to the program, including the provision of proper attire and transportation to the nearest public conveyance.

Inmates who become eligible for immediate release or whose release dates do not allow for completion of the pre-release program, will not be required to enroll and/or complete the pre-release program.
