

### **LEGAL NOTICE**

In compliance with Act 434 of 1967, the Arkansas Administrative Procedure Act, as amended, notice is hereby given that the Commissioner of Revenue for the State of Arkansas intends to adopt Rule 2007-7 titled "Administration of Special License Plates and Certificates for Persons with Disabilities." The purpose of this proposed rule is to implement the provisions of Act 753 of 2007, which (1) requires a person with a disability to obtain a disability photo ID, an endorsement on a driver's license, or an endorsement on a standard state issued ID in order to obtain a license plate or placard for disabled parking; (2) provides for a \$5.00 charge for a new ID and no charge for endorsements on an existing driver's license or state ID; (3) provides an exemption from the photo ID requirements for disabled persons who are residents of facilities that provide long-term care; and (4) requires the photo identification card to be carried by the disabled person to whom it is issued for verification of authorization to park in spaces designated for persons with a disability.

The public hearing will be held November 21, 2007, at 1:00 p.m. in the second floor conference room (#2330) of the Ledbetter Building, 1800 W. 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Little Rock, Arkansas. All interested parties may attend and present their views on the subjects and issues involved. The public comment period expires November 27, 2007. Written comments may be mailed to John H.
