Rule 2371 Amendment Summary

This Amendment of Rule 2371 clarifies the Stewards' discretion when determining whether to disqualify a horse running as a coupled entry, when there is a foul in the race.

Rule 2371 Mark Up

2371. If a horse be <u>is</u> disqualified for a foul under these Rules, any other horse in the race owned wholly or in part by the same interest or trained by the same trainer may also be disqualified <u>if the Stewards determine the second part of the coupled or uncoupled entry benefitted from the actions of the disqualified stablemate</u>.
