Thoroughbred Rule 1236 Amendment Summary

Currently, the Arkansas Racing Commission tests blood, urine and saliva of horses at Oaklawn Park. This amendment authorizes the Commission to collect and test horse hair for drugs and prohibited substances.

Thoroughbred Rule 1236 Mark Up

1236. If after a race a sample of <u>hair</u>, saliva or other excretions or body fluids is to be taken by the Commission Veterinarian from a horse that has competed in the race, nothing shall be administered or given in any manner whatsoever to the said horse (except with the permission of and in the presence of the Track Veterinarian or Commission Veterinarian) until the Commission Veterinarian obtains the sample.
