Proposed revisions will include:

- revisions to definitions
- added a requirement for written agreements with hospitals and ambulance services
- additional consent requirements
- added provision regarding pelvic exams on unconscious or anesthetized woman
- additional reporting requirements to ADH
- provision to make it a felony to conceal or remove information during an inspection
- changed the timeframe for follow-up appointment following a medical abortion
- added a requirement for reporting abortion due to criminal act to ADH
- added staffing requirement of a qualified ultrasound staff member
- added additional elements for the pregnant women viewing the ultrasound
- added human trafficking posting and Laura's card requirements
- added documentation requirements
- added a Section for Appendices
