AMENDMENTS TO THE 1988 RULES AND REGULATIONS. AM 10: 04, FOR HOSPITALS AND RELATED INSTITUTIONS IN ARRANGED FOR PURSUANT TO ACT 414 OF 1961 AS AMENDED FROCK, ARRANGED REFER TO SECTION 1806.30.3, PAGE 104

- A. Nonsprinklered buildings of one (1) story in height only shall be of at least Type II, (2,2,2) construction for new facilities. Nonsprinklered buildings of two (2) stories or more in height shall be of at least fire resistive Type I (3,3,2) construction. Protected combustible construction for one (1) story in height is acceptable for existing facilities if fully sprinklered in accordance with NFPA 13.
- B. Sprinklered buildings of one (1) story in height may be of Type II (0,0,0) construction. Sprinklered buildings of three (3) stories and less than forty-five (45) feet in height may be of Type II (1,1,1) construction. Sprinklered buildings of more than forty-five (45) feet in height, regardless of the number of stories, may be Type I (3,3,2) construction.
- C. For nonsprinklered buildings, bearing walls and walls enclosing stairways, elevator shafts, chutes, and other vertical shafts, boiler and heater rooms, laundries, kitchens, repair shops, paint shops, employee locker rooms, soiled linen rooms, storage rooms over one hundred (100) square feet in area, and trash collection rooms shall be of construction having a fire resistive rating of not less than two (2) hours. Large storerooms (one hundred (100) square feet or more), laundries, and soiled linen rooms must be sprinkled.
- D. For sprinklered buildings of less than forty-five (45) feet in height, bearing walls and walls enclosing stairways, elevator shafts, chutes, and other vertical shafts, boiler and heater rooms, laundries, kitchens, repair shops, paint shops, employee locker rooms, soiled linen rooms, storage rooms over one hundred (100) square feet in area, and trash collection rooms shall be of construction having a fire resistive rating of not less than one (1) hour.

For sprinklered buildings of more than forty-five (45) feet in height, bearing walls and walls enclosing stairways, elevator shafts, chutes, and other vertical shafts, boiler and heater rooms, laundries, kitchens, repair shops, paint shops, employee locker rooms, soiled linen rooms, storage rooms over one hundred (100) square feet in area, and trash collection rooms shall be of construction having a fire resistive rating of not less than two (2) hours.

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- E. For nonsprinklered buildings, corridor walls, smoke barrier walls, and walls separating hazardous room areas must extend to and be sealed into the structure above (roof deck or underside of the floor above) with a minimum of one (1) hour fire resistance rating.
- F. For sprinklered buildings, corridor walls shall form a barrier to limit the transfer of smoke when located within a sprinklered smoke compartment. Such walls shall be permitted to terminate at the ceiling where the ceiling is constructed to limit the transfer of smoke.
- G. An approved automatic smoke detection system must be installed in all corridors. The corridor smoke detection system may be eliminated when the involved smoke compartment is fully sprinklered. (see also Section 1806.32.6.8.H)
- H. Combustible construction including fire retardant treated wood shall not be used.
