

REPEAL


All Regulations and parts of Regulations in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION III GENERAL REQUIREMENTS
(Description of the Rule)

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To the February 1993 revision of the Arkansas Department of Health List of Controlled Substances for the State of Arkansas, it is hereby ordered that

Page 1 of 14, Section (b) (4) Alphacetylmethadol-----BY George McCue 9603,
be deleted and (4) Alphacetylmethadol (except Levo-alphacetylmethadol (LAAM)
-----9603 be added in its place.

Page 6 of 14, Section (c) be amended by redesignating the existing paragraphs (c) (11) through (c) (25) as (c) (12) through (c) (26) respectively and adding a new paragraph (c) (11) to read as follows: (c) (11) Levo-alphacetylmethadol (LAAM)-----9648.

Page 4 of 14, Section (d)-----Add: (30) Alpha-ethyltryptamine, its optical isomers, salts and salts of isomers-----7249. Some other names: Etryptamine; A-ethyl-LH-indole-3-ethanamine; 3-(2-aminobutyl) indole.

Page 5 of 14, Section (f) (8) Methcathinone (some other names: 2-(Methylamino)-1-Phenylpropan-1-one; Ephedrone: Monomethylpropion; UR1431), its salts, optical isomers, and salts of optical isomers-----1237 be deleted and (8) Methcathinone (some other names: 2-(methylamine)-Propiophenone, alpha (methylamino)-Propiophenone, 2 (methylamino)-1-phenylpropan-1-one, alpha-N-Methylaminopropiophenone, monomethylpropion, ephedrone, N-methylcathinone, methycathinone, AL-464, AL-422, AL-463 and UR-1431), its salts, optical isomers and salts of optical isomers-----1237 be added in its place.

Page 5 of 14, Section (f)-----Add: (9) AMINOREX (some other names: aminoraphen, 2-amino-5 phenyl-2-oxazoline, or 4,5 dihydro-5-phenyl-2-oxazolamine, its salts, optical isomers, and salts of optical isomers-----1585.

Page 13 of 14, Section (d) (1) Propylhexedrine-----8161 be deleted and (2) Pyrovalerone-----1485 be renumbered to read (1) Pyrovalerone-----1485.

Page 12 of 14, Section (c) (48) Zolpidem-----2783 to be added.
