## NOTICE OF RULEMAKING

Pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated §25-15-201 et seq., notice is hereby given that the Arkansas State Board of Acupuncture and Related Techniques (Board) is considering proposed revisions to its Rules and Regulations.

The proposed revisions and modifications to the Rules include, but are not limited to, the following subjects and issues: automatic licensure for uniformed service members, veterans, and spouses; pre-licensure criminal background checks; fee waivers for certain qualified applicants; and licensure eligibility for certain classes of applicants.
