Pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated §25-15-201 et seq., notice is hereby given that the Arkansas Psychology Board (Board) is considering proposed revisions to its Rules.

The proposed revisions and modifications to the Rules include, but are not limited to, the following subjects and issues: clarification of continuing education requirements; making additions consistent with Arkansas' joining of the Interjurisdictional Psychological Agreement ("Psypact"); automatic licensure for uniformed service members, veterans, and spouses; fee waivers for certain qualified applicants; licensure eligibility for certain classes of applicants; complaint procedures; removal of a fee; and pre-licensure criminal background checks.
