

## LEGAL NOTICE

The Boiler Inspection Division of the Arkansas Department of Labor and the Boiler Safety Advisory Board will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday, May 2, 2006 at 10:00 a.m. in Room 305 of the Arkansas Department of Labor, 10421 West Markham Street, Little Rock, Arkansas 72205.** The public hearing will be conducted for the purpose of accepting public comment on proposed amendments to the rules and regulations of the Boiler Inspection Division. The proposed amendments establish minimum standards for the manufacture, repair, installation, operation, and inspection of steam boilers, hot water heating and supply boilers, pressure piping, and unfired pressure vessels, including anhydrous ammonia containers. The proposed regulations deal with the licensure of boiler manufacturers, sellers, repairers, boiler operators, and boiler inspectors. The proposed amendments adopt the Model Rules recommended by the Office of the Attorney General. The proposed amendments establish procedures for obtaining a variance and for the assessment and appeal of fines.

Written comment will be accepted through 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, May 2, 2006 by the Arkansas Department of Labor at the above address.
