

## **LEGAL NOTICE**

The Arkansas Board of Electrical Examiners will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday, January 15, 2008 at 1:00 p.m. in Room 216 of the Arkansas Department of Labor, 10421 West Markham Street, Little Rock, Arkansas 72205.** The public hearing will be conducted for the purpose of accepting public comment on proposed amendments to the rules and regulations of the Board of Electrical Examiners. The proposed amendments establish minimum standards for the performance of electrical work, including the adoption of the 2008 National Electrical Code. The proposed regulations address the manner and method of addressing State Electrical Code violations, including exposing electrical work for inspection and repairing property damage caused by correcting electrical code violations. The proposed regulations deal with the licensure of electricians, including qualifications, examinations, apprentice supervision, maintaining licenses and renewing licenses. The proposed amendments adopt the Model Rules recommended by the Office of Attorney General.

Written comment will be accepted through 1:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 15, 2007 by the Arkansas Department of Labor at the above address.
