

## **LEGAL NOTICE**

The Arkansas Department of Labor will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday, November 17, 2009 at 1:00 p.m. in Room 216 of the Arkansas Department of Labor, 10421 West Markham Street, Little Rock, Arkansas.** The public hearing will be conducted for the purpose of accepting public comment on the proposed changes to the Administrative Regulations of the Arkansas Board of Electrical Examiners. The proposed changes will incorporate Act 1188 of 2009, which established a Specialist Sign Electrician limited scope electrical license. The proposed regulations implement experience and work registration requirements for this limited license. Additionally, the proposed regulations lower the examination fee for all licenses except the Industrial Maintenance License. The Industrial Maintenance examination will increase in cost. Written comment will be accepted through 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, November 17, 2009.
