NOTICE OF EMERGENCY RULE-MAKING

The Arkansas Department of Labor has issued an emergency regulation amending

Regulation 5.4 of the Administrative Regulations of the Arkansas Amusement Ride and

Amusement Attraction Safety Insurance Act. Adoption of this rule will allow the agency to

inspect mechanical bulls, gyro devices, and trackless trains on a six month basis instead of each

time the amusement ride/attraction is set up. This rule is being adopted as an emergency

regulation to immediately begin the six month inspection schedule on the effective date of Act

540 of 2013. The emergency regulation will be effective August 16, 2013, and will remain in

effect for 120 days. The agency anticipates that it will be replaced by a permanent regulation
