Proposed Rule - Assistance Fund Grant Category

This rule will broaden the existing professional development category to include grants for professional development, technical assistance, and risk assistance. $\frac{96000}{\text{Censulation}} / \text{development}$

Purpose: The Arkansas Arts Council has established an Assistance Fund to support specific arts projects. 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations, individual artists, or organizations selected for the Arts on Tour roster, and Individual Artist Fellows are eligible to apply. All requests must be for upcoming projects. Preference will be given to applicants who have never received Arts Council funds.

Limits: An applicant may request up to half of the total cost of the project. Minimum request is \$100. Maximum request is \$1,000. The amount of the request must be matched by the applicant.

Categories:

Professional Development. These funds may be requested by arts organizations for first-time participation in such professional development activities as arts-related conferences, workshops, and seminars, or to bring in consultants or facilitators to work with employees, board members, or volunteers of the organization;

Technical Assistance. These funds are restricted to artists, groups, or nonprofit organizations who have been approved for the Arts on Tour roster, the Arts in Education roster, or for past Individual Artist Fellowship winners. Visual artists may request funds for such projects as design and development of marketing materials, slide development, building of crates, consultation with marketing or other tour consultants, development of catalogue or wall labels, purchase of mounting or framing supplies, or the contracting of such services. Performing artists may request funds for such projects as design and development of marketing materials, video or audio tape development, start-up costs for touring sets, costumes or props, consultation with marketing or other tour consultants, and the repair of instruments, touring sets, costumes or props;

Risk Assistance. These funds may be requested for those projects or activities where the applicant organization must assume a higher degree of financial risk than regularly undertaken. Examples include such projects as unforeseen opportunities, bona fide emergencies, pilot projects, multi-cultural projects, or collaborative new works.

General Operating Support recipients seeking these funds must provide a strong rationale as to 1) why the project in question was not included in their currently funded application, and 2) why the project cannot be postponed until the next funding cycle.

Previous Rule - Assistance Fund

From the 1997 Guide to Grants:

A. Professional Development in the Arts

Professional development grants are available primarily to assist organizations with costs incurred when brining in consultants for program or board development. Other suggested grant areas include costs for travel to conferences or workshops, or those associated with investigating performers or exhibitors for future bookings.

Applications must include a one-page statement explaining the proposal and the organization's need for the grant, and a one-page budget outline indicating costs, matching funds, and sources. Grants are limited to \$1,000 per organization.
