Rule 5. Reciprocal, Temporary, and Expedited Licensure

- **5.4.** The Division will expedite the licensure process for: active duty military members stationed in Arkansas, returning military veterans applying for licensure within one (1) year of his or her discharge from active duty, and/or the spouse of a qualifying service member or veteran.
 - (a) A uniformed service member stationed in the State of Arkansas;
 - (b) A uniformed service veteran who resides in or establishes residency in the State of Arkansas;
 - (c) The spouse of:
 - (i) A person listed in subdivision (a) or (b) of this Rule;
 - ii) A uniformed service member who is assigned a tour of duty that
 excludes the uniformed service member's spouse from
 accompanying the uniformed service member and the spouse
 relocates to this state; and
 - (iii) A uniformed service member who is killed or succumbs to his or her injuries or illness in the line of duty if the spouse establishes residency in the state.

To qualify for expedited licensure, the applicant must notate his or her status on the application and provide the Division with a copy of the active duty orders or DD214.
