NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO RECEIVE PUBLIC COMMENT ON PROPOSED RULE CHANGES ENTITLED "2021 ARKANSAS FIRE PREVENTION CODE"

The Division of Arkansas State Police, Arkansas Department of Public Safety, is proposing to adopt the 2021 International Fire Code, International Building Code, and International Residential Code, with Arkansas Amendments as the 2021 Arkansas Fire Prevention Code. A Public Hearing will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, March 31st. The Public Hearing will be held in the Old Commission Room at the Arkansas State Police Headquarters, 1 State Police Plaza Drive, Little Rock, AR 72209.
