

NOTICE OF RULE MAKING

The Director of the Division of Developmental Disabilities Services hereby issues the following proposed DDS Policy pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 20-48-101 et seq.

The Arkansas Department of Human Services is updating DDS Policy 1076—Appeals.

This amendment modifies and updates Policy 1076 so that it aligns with the Medicaid Provider Manual’s appeal procedures and policies.
