

NOTICE OF RULE MAKING

Pursuant to Arkansas Act 762 of 2009, the Director of the Division of Medical Services within the Department of Human Services, issues revisions to the Rules and Regulations for Conducting Criminal Record Checks for Employees of Long Term Care Facilities. The Act amended Arkansas Code Title 20 to add a new chapter to read as Chapter 38 to consolidate various processes for conducting criminal record checks within the Department of Human Services for diverse service providers. The effective date of this rule will be September 1, 2009.
