The Director of the Division of Medical Services hereby issues the following proposed medical assistance rule(s) under one or more of the following chapters or sections of the Arkansas Code: 20-10-211(a), 20-10-203(b), 20-76-433, 25-10-129, and Title 20, Chapter 77.

Effective July 1, 2011, the Hearing Services provider policy manual is revised to allow school districts and education service cooperatives (ESCs) to perform certain audiology services within the school setting. This rule describes the participation criteria for schools and ESCs; the scope of services that schools and ESCs can provid; procedure codes that are non-payable to schools and ESCs; and the national place of service code that must be used to identify the school or ESC setting when billing Arkansas Medicaid.
