

NOTICE OF RULE MAKING

The Director of the Division of Medical Services hereby issues the following proposed medical assistance rule(s) under one or more of the following chapters or sections of the Arkansas Code: 20-10-211(a), 20-10-203(b), 20-76-433, 25-10-129, and Title 20, Chapter 77.

CMS identified Physician Assistants as eligible professionals to receive Electronic Health Record (EHR) incentive payments. In order to receive payment, a Physician Assistant must have an assigned practitioner identification number. Arkansas Medicaid has developed a Practitioner Identification Number Request Form as a means to enroll and assign practitioner identification numbers to eligible Physician Assistants.

Box 1437, Slot S295, Little Rock, Arkansas 72203-1437.
