NOTICE OF RULE MAKING

The Director of the Division of Medical Services hereby issues the following proposed medical assistance rule(s) under one or more of the following chapters or sections of the Arkansas Code: 20-10-211(a), 20-10-203(b), 20-76-433, 25-10-129, and Title 20, Chapter 77.

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services has approved Arkansas' request to make changes to the following three 1915 (c) Home and Community -Based Services waiver programs: ElderChoices, Alternatives for Adults with Physical Disabilities (AAPD), and Living Choices Assisted Living (LCAL) waiver.

The proposed revisions are planned for implementation January 1, 2013, and include the following:

- Implementation of an electronic universal assessment tool. The universal assessment tool will be utilized primarily for level of care determinations and in the plan of care development process for all three waivers.
- Living Choices Assisted Living (LCAL) waiver Removal of the LCAL waiver service Pharmacist Consultant Services, due to historical underutilization of the service and no current participation by providers or beneficiaries.
- Changes to the recertification requirements for waiver providers holding a license from the Office of Long Term Care or the Arkansas Department of Health.
- The process for provider training and in-services has been revised and will be a collaborative effort of DAAS and the Division of Medical Services (DMS), the Medicaid State Agency.
