## NOTICE OF RULE MAKING

The Director of the Division of Medical Services hereby issues the following proposed medical assistance rule(s) under one or more of the following chapters or sections of the Arkansas Code: 20-10-211(a), 20-10-203(b), 20-76-433, 25-10-129, and Title 20, Chapter 77.

Effective September 1, 2013, Arkansas Medicaid will add three additional standardized tests to be available for occupational and physical therapists who treat Arkansas Medicaid beneficiaries. The tests are listed as the following: Wide Range Assessment of Visual – Motor Abilities (WRAVMA)—for Occupational Therapy, Sensory Processing Measure (SPM)—for Occupational and Physical Therapy, and Sensory Processing Measure-Preschool (SPM-P)—for Occupational and Physical Therapy.
