

NOTICE OF RULE MAKING

The Director of the Division of Medical Services hereby issues the following proposed medical assistance rule(s) under one or more of the following chapters or sections of the Arkansas Code: 20-10-211(a), 20-10-203(b), 20-76-433, 25-10-129, and Title 20, Chapter 77.

Effective November 1, 2013, Arkansas Medicaid proposes to update the Rehabilitative Services for Mental Illness (RSPMI) and Inpatient Psychiatric Services for Under Age 21 manuals to explain the On-Site Inspection of Care (IOC) process, including the review tools to be utilized, conducted by the Division of Medical Services and its contractors.
