NOTICE OF RULE MAKING

The Director of the Division of Medical Services hereby issues the following proposed medical assistance rule(s) under one or more of the following chapters or sections of the Arkansas Code: 20-10-211(a), 20-10-203(b), 20-76-433, 25-10-129, and Title 20, Chapter 77.

Effective July 1, 2014, the Arkansas Department of Human Services is implementing the Arkansas Community First Choice program, the Living Choices HCBS Waiver, and the DDS HCBS Waiver. Arkansas Community First Choice is a component of the Arkansas Payment Improvement Initiative and consists of a new State plan option to provide home and community-based services and supports at a 6 percentage point increase in Federal medical assistance percentage (FMAP). Arkansas Medicaid has estimated that the 6 percentage point increase will apply to services totaling \$422 million in annual costs in state fiscal year 2015, representing \$332 million in federal spending and \$90 million in state spending.
