## NOTICE OF RULE MAKING

The Director of the Division of Medical Services hereby issues the following proposed medical assistance rule(s) under one or more of the following chapters or sections of the Arkansas Code: 20-10-211(a), 20-10-203(b), 20-76-433, 25-10-129, and Title 20, Chapter 77.

Effective October 1, 2016 Arkansas Medicaid proposes to add Hysterectomy, Appendectomy, Uncomplicated Pediatric Pneumonia and Urinary Tract Infection episodes to both the Episodes of Care Medicaid manual and the Arkansas State Plan, clarify definition of a Principal Accountable Provider (PAP) and clarify general policy guidelines regarding Episodes of Care. The estimated annualized savings for FFY2018 is \$254,170.10.
