NOTICE OF RULE MAKING

The Director of the Division of Medical Services hereby issues the following proposed medical assistance rule(s) under one or more of the following chapters or sections of the Arkansas Code: 20-10-211(a), 20-10-203(b), 20-76-433, 25-10-129, and Title 20, Chapter 77.

Effective January 1, 2016, Medicaid Hospice Payment Rates were adjusted by the Centers for Medicaid and Medicaid services (CMS). Arkansas Medicaid is updating the Hospice Policy to be in compliance with federal guidance. This rule changes the payment methodology for Routine Home Care (RHC) to implement two rates that will result in a higher base payment for the first 60 days of hospice care and a reduced base payment rate for days thereafter. This also establishes an add-on payment for services provided by a registered nurse or social worker during the last seven days of a beneficiary's life. The estimated budget impact is \$1,036,183.
