## NOTICE OF RULE MAKING

The Director of the Division of Developmental Disabilities Services hereby issues the following proposed DDS Policy pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 20-48-101 et seq.

The Arkansas Department of Human Services is updating the Developmental Day Treatment Clinic Services (DDTCS) Provider Manual, the Child Health Management Services (CHMS) Provider Manual, the DDTCS State Plan pages, the CHMS State Plan pages, and the DDS Standards for Certification, Investigation, and Monitoring.

These Provider Manual and State Plan page amendments are being made to implement a new requirement for beneficiaries to undergo an independent developmental screen. The eligibility requirements are also being modified to require that eligibility be based on the developmental screen.
