## NOTICE OF RULE MAKING

The Director of the Division of Medical Services hereby issues the following proposed medical assistance rule(s) under one or more of the following chapters or sections of the Arkansas Code: 20-10-211(a), 20-10-203(b), 20-76-433, 25-10-129, and Title 20, Chapter 77.

Effective 01-01-19 the Home Health Provider Manual has been updated to have all owners, principals, operators, employees and applicants for hospice providers to comply with criminal background checks required by law currently codified at Arkansas Code Annotated 20-33-213 and 20-38-101 et seq. Also, an old reference to ElderChoices and Alternative for Adults with Physical Disabilities is being corrected to ARChoices in Homecare.
