NOTICE OF RULE MAKING

The Director of the Division of Medical Services hereby issues notice that the public comment period for the following proposed amendment to a medical assistance rule will end on November 11, 2019. A Public Hearing was held for this rule on November 2, 2018. The original notice of rule making was published in the *Arkansas Democrat-Gazette* on October 8, 9, and 10, 2018.

Effective January 1, 2019, the Arkansas Medicaid Patient-Centered Medical Home (PCMH) provider's manual is updated to reflect the following changes: Removed definitions related to total cost of care and shared savings, and added definitions for Performance-Based Incentive Payments, Performance-Based Incentive Payment methodology, focus measure, and performance-based payment amounts; Reduced the number of weeks that enrollment is open; Clarified practice transformation payments and removed total cost of care calculations; Revised shared savings incentive payments to performance-based incentive payments. Decreased pool size to 1000, and changed savings to performance based. Changed per beneficiary cost to utilization measures and focus measures. Added the core measure requirement. Replaced shared savings with performance-based savings and total cost of care with utilization rates; and, Replaced shared-savings entities with shared-risk entities. The estimated impact was calculated to be a cost avoidance of (\$5,453,850) Federal Share; (\$2,271,150) State Share for 2019. For 2020 Federal Share is (\$10,907,700) and State Share is (\$4,542,300).
