

NOTICE OF RULE MAKING

Pursuant to A.C.A. § 9-28-103, the Director, Division of Children and Family Services issues proposed changes to Policy and Publications. These include:

- Clarifying that DCFS must meet educational stability case plan requirement at the time of each placement change, not just at initial placement into foster care.
- Adding requirement that each child 16 and older in foster care receives a copy of any consumer credit report each year until he or she exits foster care.
- Development of new forms to facilitate the referral of subsidized guardianship arrangements and notify relatives of approval.

The proposed changes are available for review at the Division of Children and Family Services, Policy Unit, 5th floor Donaghey Plaza South, 7th and Main Streets, Little Rock, AR. 72203-1437.
