

## NOTICE OF RULE MAKING

Pursuant to A.C.A. § 9-28-103, the Director, Division of Children and Family Services, issues proposed changes to the Division's drug screening policy to:

- Differentiate between a drug screen and drug test;
- Reflect current payment processing and drug screen order procedures;
- Clarify challenge procedures;
- Include national best practices as related to drug screens.
