NOTICE OF RULE MAKING

Pursuant to A.C.A. § 9-28-103, the Director, Division of Children and Family Services, proposes a new Division policy regarding when a child involved in a protective services (in home) case is missing from his/her parents' home. This new rule will ensure the State is in compliance with federal Public Law 113-183 regarding the requirement to report any child under the supervision of the state child welfare agency to the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children as well as to report to local law enforcement any youth involved with DCFS who is identified as a sex trafficking victim.
