SHORT NOTICE OF RULE MAKING

The Arkansas Department of Human Services, Division of Aging and Adult Services is proposing a new policy, Policy 226 (Health Promotion, Wellness & Disease Prevention), which requires Area Agencies on Aging (AAA) and their subcontractors to provide for health promotion, wellness and disease prevention programs, including evidence-based programs, to older adults, particularly those who have the greatest economic and/or social need and/or are in the minority in their planning area, in order to comply with the Older Americans Act of 1965, as amended.

The revised policy will be effective September 1, 2012.
