## NOTICE OF RULE MAKING

The Director of the Division of Adult, Aging, and Behavioral Health Services hereby issues the following proposed amendments to the Outpatient Behavioral Health Medicaid Provider Manual and the Behavioral Health Agency Certification Manual, under one or more of the following chapters or sections of the Arkansas Code: 20-10-211(a), 20-10-203(b), 20-76-433, 25-10-129, and Title 20, Chapter 77.

The Division of Adult, Aging and Behavioral Health Services is amending the Outpatient Behavioral Health Provider Manual and the Behavioral Health Agency Certification Manual. This amendment coincides with the implementation of the Provider-Led Arkansas Shared Savings Entity (PASSE) Organized Care Model. Under the PASSE model, the PASSE entities will be credentialing current OBH providers as Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) services providers so that they can provide behavioral health services to clients enrolled in the PASSE.

The manual amendments will apply to those providers and beneficiaries who receive behavioral health services in the fee-for-service system.

The proposed policy is available for review at the Division of Aging, Adult and Behavioral Health Services, Deputy Director for Behavioral Health's Office, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, DHS Main building, 7<sup>th</sup> and Main Street, Little Rock, Arkansas 72203-1437.
