Subj:	Disregard	of VA Aid and	Attendance	Superseded	

Effective June 1, 1995, Veterans Administration Aid and Attendance (VA A & A) will no longer be counted as income to be applied toward the vendor payment in nursing facility (NF) and ICF/MR cases. Any VA A & A payments received 6/1/95 and later will be totally disregarded, not only in the initial eligibility determination, but also in the post-eligibility process.

County offices will make adjustments to NF and ICF/MR vendor payments, effective 6/1/95, as soon as practicable.

The total disregard of VA A & A does not affect the \$2000 monthly resource consideration. Any amount of VA A & A disregarded as income will be a countable resource in the month following the month of receipt to the extent the payment is retained by the veteran. Any payment placed in a joint account will be considered fully available and a countable resource to the veteran. Cases which may be subject to resource ineligibility should be flagged for review, as appropriate.

After disregard of VA A & A in the post-eligibility process, the \$30 personal needs allowance, the spousal/dependent allowances (if any), and non-covered medical expenses will be deducted from the countable income to determine the amount to be paid toward the NF or ICF/MR vendor payment. The DCO-707 and DCO-712 are being revised to reflect the VA A & A disregard.
