## NOTICE OF RULE MAKING

The Director of the Division of Medical Services hereby issues the following proposed medical assistance rule(s) under one or more of the following chapters or sections of the Arkansas Code: 20-10-211(a), 20-10-203(b), 20-76-433, 25-10-129, and Title 20, Chapter 77.

There is a moratorium on the certification of new Rehabilitative Services for Persons with Mental Illness (RSPMI) sites. "New site" means any site not certified as an RSPMI site except: replacement sites opened by an existing provider to provide ongoing continuity of RSPMI services when the provider is terminating services at a currently certified and operating RSPMI site; sites in continuous lawful operation furnishing RSPMI services since May 31, 2008. The moratorium shall be in effect until June 30, 2017, unless altered by amendment of this rule.
