



## NOTICE OF RULEMAKING

Pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 25-25-101 et seq., notice is hereby given that the Arkansas State Board of Architects, Landscape Architects, and Interior Designers (ASBALAID) is considering the proposed revisions to its Rules and Regulations.

The proposed revisions and modifications to the Rules include, but are not limited to, the following subjects and issues: Definitions, General Provisions, Board Operations, Applications, Registration Standards, Examination, Continuing Education, Licensure Renewals, Practice of Architecture, Scope of Practice, Unlicensed Practice, Professional Conduct, Construction Administration, Buildings Constructed without an Architect, Fee Schedules, Sanctions, and Rules of Procedure. The proposed rule changes may impact licensed architects and unlicensed individuals (including property owners, contractors, and other professionals).
