- 1. What is the subject of the proposed rule? The Annual License fee paid by Burial Associations that operate in Arknasas.

It is necessary because the current fees do not bring in enough revenue to fund the Board operations. Consequently, the Board has used savings to subsidize the budget, and they too are diminishing.
- 5. Will this proposed rule be controversial? If yes, explain nature of controversy. I don't think that the rule will be controversial because the fees have not been increased for 5 years.

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- The Financial impact of this rule is an additional \$30,000 annually, spread over 155 Associations.

PROPOSED RULE FOR BURIAL ASSOCIATIONS ANNUAL FEE EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1995

The Annual License Fee Schedule for Burial Associations shall be as follows:

For Burial Associations with a membership of 1 to 1000, the annual fee shall be \$600;

For Burial Associations with a membership of 1001 to 2500, the annual fee shall be \$700;

For Burial Associations with a membership of 2501 to 5000, the annual fee shall be \$1000;

For Burial Association with a membership of 5001 to 7500. the annual fee shall be \$1100;

For Burial Associations with a membership of 7501 to 10,000, the annual fee shall be \$1200;

For Burial Associations with a membership of 10,001 to 15,000, the annual fee shall be \$1400;

For Burial Associations with a membership of 15,001 to 20,000, the annual fee shall be \$1500;

For Burial Associations with a membership of 20,000 or more, the annual fee shall be \$1600.
