The proposed Rule Amendments are related to certain administrative changes necessary because NCEES (the organization that develops and administers engineer and surveyor competency exams) is changing the format for the Fundamentals of Engineering and Fundamentals of Surveying examinations from pen and paper to computer-based beginning in 2014. As a result of that change, the admittance procedures for examinees are being modified so that it will no longer be necessary for applicants/examinees to submit an application to and be admitted by the Board prior to taking either of these exams, but rather register directly with NCEES – those passing may then apply to the Board for licensure. These changes requires relatively minor amendments to Articles 8, 9 & 11 of the Board's rules.
