MORATORIUM ON PERMIT OF APPROVAL APPLICATIONS

A moratorium is hereby in effect for 120 days on the acceptance of Permit of Approval Applications by the Health Services Agency. The moratorium includes, but is not limited to, applications that involve additional beds not previously approved by the Commission or any application for a new facility/service which is subject to the Commission's review authority. The moratorium does not include construction solely necessary for modernization, life safety code compliance, the mere replacement of older facilities, or the movement of previously approved beds.

An Emergency has been declared due to the serious budget problems being experienced by the Medicaid program. Additional health care providers competing for limited private and public funds could exacerbate this crisis. An emergency is declared to exist because the stability of the Medicaid program and health care providers effect the health and welfare of the public.
