AMENDMENT
to the
HEALTH SERVICES COMMISSION'S
NURSING HOME METHODOLOGY

The Commission will consider applications that include the movement of a nursing home across service area lines only if:

1. The beds per 1,000 population ratio (for persons 85 years and over) in the county, where the facility is located, exceeds the statewide average by 50%;
2. The county to which the home is to be relocated has less than the statewide average beds per 1,000 persons 85 and over;
3. The county to which the home is to be relocated has only one (1) nursing home; and
4. The county into which the facility proposed to be moved has two judicial districts.

Facilities constructed prior to 1965 would receive priority for transfer.
