"A psychiatric residential treatment facility DEFINITION: means any non-hospital establishment with permanent facilities which provides a 24 hour program of care by qualified therapists to include, but not be limited to, duly licensed mental health professionals, psychiatrists, psychologists, psychotherapists, and licensed certified social workers, for emotionally disturbed children and adolescents who are not in an acute phase of illness requiring the services of a psychiatric hospital, and are in need of restorative treatment services. An establishment furnishing primarily domiciliary care is not within the (Act 609 of 1985) definition."

Population Based Methodology I.

- A. Projection Time Frame Each July 1st bed need will be projected five years from the current year, ie. July 1, 1995 projections will be made for the year 2000.
- Service Area State of Arkansas B.
- Bed Need Formula -C.
 - .385 beds per 1000 persons age 6-17 1) .300 beds per 1000 persons age 18-21
 - Before additional beds may be approved existing PRTF's must have averaged 80% occupancy for the previous calendar year.
- Review Priorities applicants will be approved in the following ranked order:
 - 1) Existing PRTF's with an average annual occupancy of 90% or greater.
 - 2) Existing PRTF's wishing to expand and replace an SY older facility.

Applicants for new PRTF's in sections of the State that are more than one and half hours travel time from existing PRTF's.

Utilization Based Methodology

An existing facility may be approved for up to ten (10) additional beds if the facility had an average occupancy of 90% for the previous calendar year.
