HSC REGULATION 010PP.E. Permit of Approval/Exemption from Review.

For the time period commencing December 27, 1995 and ending April 24, 1996 (or 120 days) Crittenden County is exempt from Permit of Approval review for Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facilities which agree to serve youthful sex offenders. This exemption applies only to facilities which:

- submitted a proposal under the 1995 DHS Request for Proposals to serve such populations;
- 2) received a ranking of one (1) or two (2) in the RFP process; and
- 3) apply, and are licensed, during the period of exemption for 25 beds or less in a site in Crittenden County.

HEALTH SERVICES AGENCY
STATEMENT OF EMERGENCY

HSC Regulation 010PP.E. Permit of Approval/Exemption from Review.

Pursuant to authority granted the Health Services Commission by Arkansas Act 593 of 1987, as amended, this emergency rule was adopted on December 15, 1995. This regulation sets forth the time period during which Crittenden County is exempt from Permit of Approval Review for Psychiatric Residential Treatment Facilities which agree to serve youthful sex offenders. The Commission finds that imminent peril to the public's health, safety, and welfare requires adoption of this rule to be effective immediately upon filing on December 27, 1995. Under a legislative mandate to treat these youths in-state, the Department of Human Services solicited, received and rated requests for proposal for such a facility. This emergency rule will allow a party receiving a high ranking from DHS to be exempt from review for a 25 bed facility to treat youthful sex offenders. There is an immediate need to open such a facility in East Arkansas which has no such facilities so that service may be provided close to the youth's home. necessary to ensure that these youthful offenders are not turned away due to the unavailability of services, to ensure that these individuals receive proper treatment, and to avoid potential problems created by these individuals. Treating these youth instate rather than out-of-state will also save the money. All regulations in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
